What is Pickleball?

Pickleball is a fun game that is played on a badminton court with the net lowered to 34 inches at the center. It is played with a perforated plastic baseball (similar to a whiffle ball) and wood or composite paddles. It is easy for beginners to learn, but can develop into a quick, fast-paced, competitive game for experienced players.

Welcome to Pickleball in Barnstable

We offer recreational games for experienced players at all skill levels

OPEN PLAY

Participation requires that you be able to play in a game. That means you have knowledge of the rules, scoring, doubles court position, and the ability to serve and rally. No instruction during this time.

If interested in playing at HYCC you must register with Barnstable Pickleball by sending your email address to: barnstablepickleball@gmail.com ATTN: Bill Dado

Playing at the scheduled times is done by on-line registration. An email is sent to those registered Saturday afternoon for Monday play and Monday afternoon for Wednesday play. There will be a link in the email for the sign up screen. You may sign up for one two hour block each day. A maximum of twenty-four players is allowed at each time. A confirmation list of all who have signed up to play will be emailed the day before.

- Upon entering the gymnasium, cross off your name on the list of scheduled players, which is on a clipboard on the bleacher bench, and deposit the fee into the blue envelope.
- All balls are provided for the games.
- A white board grid is used to organize all games.
- Information on how to enter into a game, along with the ability/skill descriptions and ratings scale is posted on the white board.
- Upon arriving, read our guidelines and then choose the color pen that corresponds with your skill level. Red – Advanced, Blue – Intermediate, Green – Novice.
- Write your name into an open box, either in a row which already contains other players' color coded names, or in a blank row to organize a new game.
- You can choose to play with those at any skill level or those at your skill level.
- If you only want to play with others at your level CIRCLE your name.
- If you want to play a game with a specific person or group you can write in the name(s) of the other players ONLY when all in the group are out and waiting to play. There is NO reserving of a spot/row on the board.
- When a court is available the next row of players goes out for their game and erases their names from the board.
- When your game is finished, to enter another game, write your name in an empty box on the board, then have a seat on the bleachers to rest, recover and socialize while waiting for your next game.

INSTRUCTION - NOVICE PRACTICE

- Always "drop-in," no previous registration required.
- Upon entering the gymnasium, go to the two back courts behind the center partition, sign the sheet in the white three ring notebook and deposit the fee into the blue envelope.
- All balls are provided. Some loner paddles are available.
- Time will be spent on drills in the fundamentals and in playing practice points and games.
