The Significance of July 27th and 10 AM

***The Armistice Agreement for the
Restoration of the South Korean State***

This armistice signed on July 27, 1953, formally ended the war in Korea. North and South Korea remain separate and occupy almost the same territory they had when the war began.

The Korean War, which began on June 25, 1950, when the North Koreans invaded South Korea, officially ended on July 27, 1953. 10:00 AM, which is the time (in the Far East) when the armistice was signed, with the cease fire going into effect at 10:00 PM.
