BOARD OF HEALTH MEETING MINUTES Tuesday, September 27, 2022 3:00 PM

ZOOM MEETING 8267 0676 703

A regularly scheduled and duly posted meeting of the Barnstable Board of Health was held on Tuesday, September 27, 2022. The meeting was called to order at 3:00 pm by, John Norman, Chair. Also in attendance were Board Members Thomas Lee, Donald Guadagnoli, M.D., Daniel Luczkow, M.D., Paul Canniff, D.M.D., and Stephen Waller, M.D. Thomas McKean, Director of Public Health, and Sharon Crocker, Administrative Assistant, were also present.

I. Innovative/Alternative (I/A) Septic System:

Chuck Rowland, Sullivan Engineering, representing Jane and Steven Hoch, owner – 180 Carriage Road, Osterville, Map/Parcel 071-015, 1.63 acre parcel, currently has an eight (8) bedroom system, proposing use of KleanTu NitROE Waste-Water Treatment and requesting a variance from Saltwater Estuary Protection to allow an additional bedroom for a total of nine (9) bedrooms.

Chuck Rowland presented the plan which would be tying the pool house/cabana and the sun room into the main system. The prior septic for the pool house/cabana has been disconnected. Using the Klean Tu, he anticipates a 90% reduction in nitrogen from system. Klean Tu is approved for Provisional Use and they are pursuing approval for General Use. Mr. Rowland clarified the lot size is 80,755 square feet (not 71K).

Mr. McKean said the staff did not have any objections.

Mr. Rowland said the property is currently Seasonal Use and may change in future.

Mr. Lee stated the system is a very good product when the property is used year-round. He believes, with seasonal use, it will still provide a good reduction in the amount of nitrogen released even with an additional bedroom.

The Board discussed the project and the opportunity to get the I/A system installed. The owner is currently doing some construction and had considered changing system during this process. If denied, they would be installing a regular system which won't be as beneficial.

Upon a motion duly made by Dr. Canniff, seconded by Dr. Guadagnoli, the Board voted to approve the Klean Tu NitROE Waste-Water Treatment with the condition that the additional bedroom will be permitted when the system receives approval for MA DEP for General Use

without returning to Board. (Mr. Rowland will look into attaching the pool house/cabana and sunroom in front of the Klean Tu, however, this is not a condition of the Board's. Roll Call: Mr. Lee-Yes, Dr. Guadagnoli-Yes, Dr. Luczkow-Yes, Dr. Canniff-Yes, Mr. Norman-Yes. (Unanimously, in favor.)

II. Body Artist: Tattooing Only.

Michael Romasco is applying as a new body artist (tattooing) to work with Mark Corliss, owner of Spilt Milk Tattoo – 548 Main Street, Hyannis, Map/Parcel 308-074-00C. Had Body Art training on March 18, 2011 and is working in RI. Michael is looking to work out of the Spilt Milk Tattoo Establishment for two days during October.

Michael Romasco was not able to make the meeting. Mark Corliss was present. Michael has worked for 15 years as a body artist and is well-known in the industry as an exceptional artist. He is interested in Cape Cod and would like to work for 2 days at Spilt Milk prior to the Board's November meeting. If interested in remaining on Cape, he would gladly attend the approved Skin Course for Body Artists.

The Board discussed the body art variance for 2-5 day time period. If applicant applies for a full permit, he must follow the usual procedure and return to the Board to be approved.

Upon a motion duly made by Dr. Guadagnoli, seconded by Dr. Canniff, the Board voted to grant a body art variance to allow a body artist permit for a five (5) day period (to be arranged with the Health Division) permitting Michael Romasco to perform as a body artist working under Mark Corliss at Spilt Milk Tattoo. Roll Call: Mr. Lee-Yes, Dr. Guadagnoli-Yes, Dr. Luczkow-Yes, Dr. Canniff-Yes, Mr. Norman-Yes. (Unanimously, voted in favor.)

III. Minutes:
