- 1. Upon a quorum duly present, Chairman Curtis called the CFAC meeting to order at 7:05 PM in the Selectman's Conference Room.
- 2. Upon a motion made and seconded, the minutes of 12.03.07 were approved.

### 3. Staff Comments:

Mark M. updated the committee on the status of the RFP for the disposition of the Osterville Bay elementary school. Two major issues to be resolved are: 1. What portion of the property is being disposed and 2. What zoning changes need to take place, if any? Mark mentioned that the village assoc. will be weighing in on these issues.

Ralph K. suggested that John C. attend any Osterville Village Association meetings where this may be discussed as he has been asked to serve on the RFP evaluation committee. Mark said that John could contact David Anthony, the Town's CPO as he is directing the development of the RFP.

Mark M. informed the committee that the Town Council approved a factor of 1 and a 20% residential exemption for FY08 and the tax rates for FY08 have been approved by the DOR.

### 4. Old Business:

<u>Charter review sub-committee</u> - Ralph K. commented that the Charter Comm. Has scheduled meetings for Tuesdays and Thursdays. They plan to invite civic associations to meetings beginning in January. The Hyannis Civic Assoc. is on the docket for April 10<sup>th</sup>.

John C. asked if other committees have formally been invited. Ralph K. did not know. John c. asked CFAC members if he should approach the chairman of the Charter Comm. or write a letter asking if they will solicit input from CFAC. Bill B. said he would like to have the Charter Comm. Invite CFAC but CFAC would have to approach them since they probably don't know the CFAC members.

Ralph K. commented that CFAC should try to find out what the Charter Comm.'s philosophy and thought process is about committees.

Mark M. suggested that CFAC attend a public hearing to bring up these questions. John C. said he would go to a meeting to discuss this with the Charter Comm. Ralph K. suggested that it could be done either way - approach the Charter commission or go to a public hearing.

<u>Update on CIP review</u> - Jim S. has gone through the school portion. He would like to interview the school dept. on Jan 7<sup>th</sup>, 9am in the Selectmen's Conference Room. Mark will try to set this up. Jim s. would like to have Joe Slominski come in to describe the program and details as to how they arrived at the figures submitted.

John C. asked if anyone else should be invited. Sub committee need more time to determine this. Bill B. suggested that they wait until January 7<sup>th</sup> when they meet again to decide this. Mark will inform all other department heads of their potential to be invited to a meeting on the 21<sup>st</sup> with CFAC.

Ralph K. asked what was happening at the airport. Has the airport considered the water issued associated with any capital plan? Should CFAC address this?

### 5. New Business:

### Review of Community Preservation Fund

At the request of Councilor Munafo, Mark M. reviewed several financial reports (copies attached) with CFAC that highlighted the financial activity of the Community Preservation Fund. These included:

- 6. Schedule of Continuing Appropriations as of November 14, 2007.

Ralph K. asked how entities know how to access these funds. Mark will ask the Community Preservation Committee what they have done for outreach efforts.
