B. Trade Winds Development A Inc John Howe - 780 Craigville Beach Road

SE3-4385

Alteration of a wetland resource area and violation of an order of conditions and approved plan of record under

SE3-4385, by building a bridge in an area that was slated as a grow-back area for mitigation. Non-compliance with approved landscaping plan, dated April 22, 2008. Demarcation of "no disturbance" line was to be identified. Fire pit area and storage of material in 50' buffer. Additional planting needed in area of gazebo; un-permitted shed(s).

A motion was made to approve an amended enforcement order. An amended order will be required for any proposed landscape plan changes.

C. Elva L. and Lawrence F. OBrien III Trs. – 205 Ocean View Avenue, Cotuit Violation of an enforcement order – continuing to cut understory vegetation on a coastal bank. Cutting over property line onto #225 without authorization.

The matter was tabled to January 14, 2014, to enable the attendance of Attorney Albert Schulz.

No testimony was taken.

D. William Philip Kelly Admin., c/o Peter Kelly – 75 Pheasant Way, Centerville SE3-4322 Violation of an order of conditions and certificate of compliance, under SE3-4322, by mowing and boat storage beyond work limit line, and recorded conservation restriction; installation of an outdoor shower; violation of prior enforcement orders (1995 and 2002) by rebuilding boardwalk to Centerville River.
