The Chair, John Jope, introduced a guest speaker, Ted Lowrie, Jr. of Barnstable Neighbor 2 Neighbor. Mr. Lowrie provided an overview of the history and scope of services offered to members of Barnstable Neighbor 2 Neighbor. The all-volunteer organization is a non-profit (501)(c)(3) serving all seven villages of Barnstable. Barnstable Neighbor 2 Neighbor assesses an annual membership fee that entitles members up to 12 service requests per month. Services include transportation, light household tasks, etc. Since 2021, more than 3,200 services have been provided to 90-95 members. Approximately 125 volunteers support the service network.
