STAFFING CHANGE

HYCC Facility Manager position has been re-posted and interviews were conducted last week (July 6th and 7th). We are looking forward to filling the position with a highly qualified candidate. *Joe Izzo stated seventeen applicants, seven deemed qualified based on the HR job description. Interviews were conducted by Bill Cole Human Resource Director, John Tassinari, Fleet Supervisor DPW, he knows everything Zamboni, and myself. We now are reviewing, then recommendation to Lynne Poyant, then the Town Manager; hope to have a decision by Wednesday or Thursday.*
