# IV. STAFF REPORT – PATTI MACHADO (Handout A)

#### A. Administration

- 1. Buildings are open
  - a. HYCC as well as the Barnstable Community Building and the Osterville Community Building, which are available for user permits.
  - b. Centerville Community Building is being finished up and will be available as soon as it is complete.
  - c. HYCC operational hours are 8:3AM to 4:30PM M-F until further notice.
  - d. All user agreements are continuing as scheduled.
- 2. Department continues to struggle getting staff
  - a. HYCC for public skate and open gym
  - b. Lifeguards, beaches, and the summer leisure program

# B. Aquatics

- 1. Parking Permits
  - a. Sold around 21,000 beach permits to date
    - i. 4,000 more to date than all of last year and 1,000 more than 2 years ago
  - b. Turn-around time is approximately one week
- 2. Lifeguards
  - a. Tryouts are continuing whenever someone applies
  - b. Currently no lifeguards on duty at Wequaquet Lake and Hamblin's Pond
- 3. Water Safety Swimming Instructor
  - a. Class certification is being offered evenings in order to have enough instructors next summer
- 3. Weather has been tough since we opened fully on June 25<sup>th</sup>

# C. HYCC

- 1. Summer Eats Lunch Program managed by Mark Boardley is available to any child who stops by Mon-Fri 11:30AM 2PM
- 2. Cape Cod Culinary Incubators is currently providing meals from the HYCC every other Thursday from 4-6PM
- 3. Camps are running at the HYCC
  - a. Hockey, Volleyball, and Basketball
- 4. Ice Rinks
  - a. Kennedy Rink dehumidifiers are down
  - b. Butler Rink has been rebuilt back up and is in use
- 5. Public Skate and Walk-on Figure Skating are being held on Sundays more staff needed to expand offerings

#### D. Recreation Programs

- 1. Summer Recreation Programs are in full swing
- 2. Summer Leisure Program
  - b. Sold out of 3 locations so added a 4<sup>th</sup> which sold out as well
  - c. Biggest challenge has been getting staff

#### E. Youth Commission

- 1. Town Council approved addition of four more commissioners
  - a. All but one spot filled
