- III. STAFF REPORT PATTI MACHADO (Handout A)
 - A. Administration
 - 1. HYCC
 - a. Fully Open with working hours Monday Friday 8:30AM 4:30PM
 - b. Working on hiring staff in order to expand hours

c. Floor in the gym is being resurfaced and new volleyball stations put in

B. Aquatics

- 1. Parking Permits
 - a. Sold around 15,000 beach permits to date
 - b. Town's online system OpenGov for applying for permits is being used this year
 - c. Turn-around time is about 3 weeks but people are being allowed into the beach with last year's sticker or their printed receipt from the online application through June 25th
 - d. Beach stickers are not being issued in person but people can come into the building with questions or to get a paper application

2. Lifeguards

- a. Currently 21 Lifeguards short
- b. Another certification class is being held next week at night at Craigville Beach
- c. Due to the crisis situation approval has been granted to reimburse the Lifeguard Certification fee once a person has completed the class, completed tryouts, and gets hired by the town
- d. If all positions aren't filled, a priority list as to where Lifeguards will be stationed will be created with signs posted stating No Lifeguards On Duty on those locations without them

3. Beaches

- a. Vets, Kalmus, Keyes, Covell's, Craigville, and Dowses have been open weekends
- b. All sites will be fully operational on June 26th (depending on Lifeguards that are hired)
- c. Portables are at all sites for nights and weekends

C. HYCC

- 1. Barnstable Recreation continues to collaborate with Cape Cod Culinary Incubators to provide meals at the HYCC
 - a. They will be serving meals every other Friday from now on (June 11, 25, etc.)
 - b. For the next couple of weeks, Wheldon Library will be giving books to children with the meals for their summer reading
- 2. Kennedy Rink is fixed and operational
 - a. Going with one rink through mid-August so Butler will be shut down
- 3. Gym Floor is being redone so the gym and walking track will be closed from June 7 June 21
- 4. Hoping to be fully operational with public skate, open gym, etc. come June 26th

D. Recreation Programs

- 1. Spring Programs are in full swing
- 2. Summer Leisure Program Registration
 - a. Added an additional section for grades 1-5
 - b. 2 spots are left in the section for grades 6-8
 - c. Field trips will take place this year

- 1. One Love Program
 - a. Presented at Sturgis East and Sturgis West virtually
 - b. It was delivered to 149+ seniors
 - c. Met with Superintendent and Interim Principal of Barnstable High School
