I. CALL TO ORDER:

Chairman John Meade called the meeting to order at 7pm.

II. MINUTES:

Motion was made and approved to accept the minutes of April 28, 2009.

III. NOTICES OF INTENT (NOI):

Town of Barnstable – 114 Freezer Rd. (Marina Bulkhead)

Dale Saad notified the Committee that Conservation Commission had received the NOI from Vine Associates and is on their agenda for

June 21, 2009. She explained that the Barnstable Marina bulkhead would be all steel construction extending the top by 1' with wood cap, no dredging.

VII. CORRESPONDENCE:

Linda Hutchenrider, Town Clerk, regarding resignations. Any person who resigns from his/her position on a board/committee or commission which is effective prior to the completion of his/her term – must write a resignation letter to the Town Clerk in order for it to be official.

VIII. HARBORMASTER REPORT:

Eric Shufelt and Joe Gibbs reported that the Gary Brown/Lewis Bay boat ramp is up and running. Dredging will occur in June.

Eric Shufelt reported that Blish Point parking and ramp are open and operational. All 4 Town marinas are opened and staffed. All Harbormaster boats are in the water with the exception of the second pumpout boat which will be put in the end of June. At Bismore Park, the new pumpout system is installed and running. The old pump is now at Prince Cove and will be working on getting that running. In June, there will be Maritime Days at Hyannis Harbor; on June 13th there will be a Marine Inspection Day at Gateway Marina. He is working through the waitlist to fill slip vacancies in the Town Marinas.

Joe Gibbs reported that all buoys are in the water with the exception of Lake Wequaquet which will go in this week. To date there are 93 people who have not renewed their mooring permits, 20 have notified the Harbormaster Office surrendering them. Many are from the lakes which are open areas. The new boat purchased from the Port Security grant should be here in the next few weeks and be ready by the 4th of July.
