Notice of Intent (NOI):

1. O'Brien, Timothy R, Trustee, Windswept Way Realty Trust, 196 Windswept Way, Osterville, MA Map 052 Parcel 002-002. Applicant is proposing to construct and maintain a boardwalk, a seasonal pier, ramp and float in Cotuit Bay.

2. White, James N & O'Brien, Patricia A, Trustees, White Revocable Trust; 50 Fox Island Road, Osterville, MA Map 096 Parcel 001. Applicants are proposing to replace the existing 32' ell with a 21' ell extended 5' further from shore and rotated approximately 10 degrees, and to relocate the existing float from the north side of the pier to the south side of the pier and expand from 160 sf to the allowable 200 sf.

Correspondence: Beacon Marine Construction would like to apply for a commercial mooring permit in the Cordwood Mooring Field. The Waterways Committee believes that Beacon Marine serves as positive benefit to the Town of Barnstable, the public and our waterways. This is an annual mooring permit only. Location will be determined by the Harbormasters office.

Harbor Master Report: Harbormaster's Office is busy permitting the mooring renewals. With the spring upon us the mooring officer will be meeting with all mooring servicers to strength relationships and communication. Channel markers will be placed in the water starting in April. Harbormaster staff will be offering moorings starting April 1st. A mass mailing will be sent out by email. Lastly, Derek Lawson is now the supervisor of the Harbormaster Department. Dan Horn is still the Harbormaster but is also now the MEA Department Director.
