#### b. One Love

- ii. Target age will be sophomores
- iii. There is a multi-media "Behind The Post" presentation followed by break out groups for discussion afterwards
- iv. Mary spoke with Ms. Regan about setting up a meeting to get this started

### c. Youth Summit

- i. This event is for the entire 7<sup>th</sup> grade class entering high school the following year
- ii. It informs them on what life is like at the high school and what they to expect
- iii. Clubs and peer leaders from the high school participate
- iv. There are now peer mediators who work with the peer leaders who will be helpful in the organization of the event
- v. Ms. Wojkowski is the head of the National Honor Society and will be able to assist in getting students from this group to participate
- vi. This event requires the most work of all the events throughout the year and requires a lot of people's participation

#### d. Job Fair

- i. This brings in local businesses who offer employment to youth
- ii. It is held in March
- iii. Last year 40 businesses came to participate
- iv. 380 students attended

## e. Food Drive

- i. Was a new event last year
- ii. Students go to various food stores to get donations
- iii. Will be held on Super Bowl Sunday, February 9, 2025
- iv. The National Honor Society helped last year
- v. Food collected will go to a food pantry
