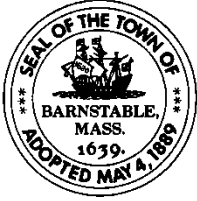

Todays Update #2: Muddy/Crocker Pond, Marstons Mills is now a warning level. Long Pond, Centerville, is now removed from the warning level.

Long Pond, Marstons Mills is closed to swimming due to high levels of Cyanobacteria

BEACH CLOSED **TOXIC CYANOBACTERIA** in pond water

To protect yourself and pets:

- **Do not drink pond water.**
- **Do not swim.**
- **Keep pets and livestock away.**
- **Avoid areas with scum while boating and do not eat fish.**

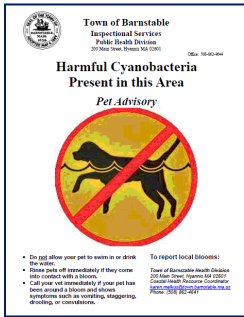
