# **Dowses Beach and Bathhouse**



# **ADA Transition Plan**

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#### Background

Dowses Beach Bathhouse is located at 348 East Bay Road in Osterville. The beach is open from Memorial Day to Labor Day, with lifeguards on duty at lifeguard stations daily from 9:00 AM to 5:00 PM. Parking in the lot is free.

The bathhouse is located at the south end of a parking lot. The only entry and exit point to and from the bathhouse is through steep walkways and a staircase. A wooden walkway provides an access route to the beach. There are nine (9) beach access routes starting from the borders of the parking lot which is almost completely surrounded by vegetation and beach sand extending to the ocean. Some of the access routes are likely the product of desire lines and include paths that would be very difficult to navigate even if a beach mat were provided over the ground surface.

**Note:** See Figure 1 on Page 2 of this report showing the suggested location for additional beach access routes that could be created with the use of beach mats.

The bathhouse contains one (1) women's toilet room, one (1) men's toilet room, and a lifeguard room. The women's toilet room contains three (3) toilet compartments. The men's toilet room has two (2) compartments and two (2) urinals. The lifeguard room is for staff only. Amenities around the bathhouse include a picnic table and a bench near the bathhouse on its north side. A bike rack and an inaccessible portable toilet are located by the northern portion of the parking lot. Additional amenities include a pier and viewing platform at the north end of the parking lot, and beach umbrellas at multiple locations.

The parking lot contains 220 parking spaces. This includes four (4) car accessible spaces and two (2) van accessible parking spaces at the south end of the lot by the bathhouse, and five (5) car accessible parking spaces at the north end of the lot by the pier and viewing platform.

The viewing platform that has staircases leading to the beach. Once at the viewing area there are benches at lowered railing that create accessible fishing points.

**Note:** On the beach level next to the viewing platform there is an engraved stone from the Barnstable Disability Commission attesting to the existence of disability being a normal part of the human experience.

#### **Key Accessibility Issues**

#### Ramps

The walkway starting near the parking lot, below and north of the bathhouse, has a sufficient running slope to be considered a ramp. It lacks handrails and edge protection. There is also lack of a ramp which is necessary to create an accessible route from where a staircase north of the bathhouse leads to the one entry and egress on the north side of the bathhouse.

#### Doors

The entry and egress door to the bathhouse building is narrower than the minimum width required.

**Beach Access Routes** There is a lack of a stable and firm beach access route to at least one of the available beach umbrellas, a wooden beach access route accessed by a walkway that joins the wooden route at the rinsing shower does not extend all the way to the high tide level, and there is lack of a stable and firm beach access route at Access Point #5 and at Access Point #9 extending to the accessibility monument, the beach area below the viewing platform and the high tide level.

**Rinsing Shower** Accessibility issues at the rinsing shower include lack of two fixed shower heads mounted at 48" and 72" inches above the ground, and lack of water controls that are mounted within reach range.

In addition, the accessible route to and within the rinsing shower is not maintained in operable working condition.

#### Toilet Rooms

Accessibility issues with the toilet rooms in the bathhouse include lack of an accessible toilet compartment, lack of knee clearance at the lavatory and a mirror mounted higher than the maximum height allowed in both the men's and women's toilet rooms. The men's toilet room has exposed plumbing below the lavatory.

#### **Additional Accessibility Issues**

- An access aisle at a car accessible space near the bathhouse is narrower than the minimum width required, and multiple parking identification signs at both accessible parking locations are obscured by vegetation.
- Lack of an accessible portable toilet with 60" min. x 72" min. clear floor space at the toilet.
- Exterior access routes have excessive cross slopes and are • not maintained in operable working condition due to the presence of beach sand.
- Lack of an accessible picnic table located on an accessible route.

## **Order of Magnitude Cost Estimates**

- Renovate toilet rooms: \$16,340
- Renovate and provide compliant ramps: \$11,722
- Provide accessible beach access routes (beach mats): • \$5,647
- Provide handrails with a compliant cross section: \$4,440 •
- Widen the entry door at the bathhouse: \$3,366 ٠
- Renovate rinsing shower: \$2,719
- Miscellaneous corrective actions (parking, exterior access • routes, picnic table, etc.): \$2,180

## Total: \*\$46,414

\*Note: Cost to extend the existing wood beach access route to the high tide level and for an accessible portable toilet is not provided.

## **Best Practice and Inclusive Design**

Best practice and inclusive design recommendations include elements that are not required in the standards but may create enhanced experiences for all users.

- Recommend extending beach access route to at least one lifeguard station so a visitor with a mobility disability could navigate to a lifeguard station should the need arise.
- Recommend using beach mat material to create accessible sitting areas that extend for beach access routes and are located near the high tide level.
- When an accessible picnic table is provided on an accessible route, IHCD recommends providing a stable, firm and slipresistant surface for 48" clear on all sides of the picnic table. See the following illustration:





Figure 1: Red numbers show possible beach access points, with the X showing a beach access point that is marked as closed. The blue lines indicate the location where a beach access route could possibly be added (beach mat) including a route to at least one of the beach umbrellas. The yellow line shows the route of an existing asphalt walkway reaching the rinsing shower and a wooden beach access route, which is colored gray. The wooden access route should be extended to the high tide level.
