ADA Transition Plan

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Background

The Centerville Recreation Building is located at 524 Main Street in Centerville. Originally a church and then a post office, it is currently a recreation building. According to reporting in *The Barnstable Patriot* regarding the building's use, "...it is host to a Summer Leisure Program, for students going into first through fifth grade, and runs for eight weeks in the summer, featuring activities such as arts and crafts, games, and outings such as mini golf and bowling. The building can also be rented out for use as a venue."

There is a parking lot on the east side of the building adjacent to the main entrance with 13 parking spaces and two (2) accessible spaces. One (1) parking space is designated van accessible. An additional 11 parking spaces are provided on the west side of the building including one (1) van accessible parking space. A softball field is located to the west of the building behind the rear parking lot, and the Centerville Playground is located down an incline to the south of the building.

Note: The Centerville Playground is the subject of a separate narrative report and survey catalog.

The building has a basement, a first floor and a second floor. There is a ramp leading to the accessible main entrance on the first floor on the east side of the building. There is an inaccessible egress on the east side of the building as well. There is also an accessible entrance to the basement on the west side of the building which leads to a lift that provides vertical access between the basement and first floor. In addition, there are two (2) inaccessible egresses on the west side of the building, one exiting from the basement level and the other exiting to an exterior set of stairs on the second floor. Two (2) interior staircases connect all floors, but there is no accessible vertical access to the second floor.

The basement has one (1) men's and one (1) women's multi-user toilet room and a large meeting room. The first floor has a men's

and women's single-user toilet room, a summer activities room and a kitchen. On the second floor there is one (1) meeting room, and one (1) classroom.

Note: If an accessible route is not provided to the second floor, relocate any programing that takes place on the second floor to the first floor, the basement or to another accessible location.

Key Accessibility Issues

Exterior Accessible Routes

Accessibility issues include walkways with running and cross slopes that are greater than allowed, excessive changes in level and surfaces that do not prevent the accumulation of water. There is also lack of a firm, stable and slip-resistant accessible route from the parking lot on the west side of the building to a softball field and to player seating on the first and third base sides of the softball field.

Interior Accessible Routes

Accessibility issues include lack of accessible vertical access between the first and second floors and an interior ramp on the basement level with excessive running and cross slopes.

Stairs

Accessibility issues include handrails with noncompliant cross sections on the egress stairs from the second floor. The handrails on the staircase from the first floor to the basement are mounted lower than the minimum height required and do not extend at least one tread length beyond the bottom riser.

Signage

Accessibility issues include lack of directional signage from inaccessible entrances to the nearest accessible entrance, lack of signs from inaccessible egresses to the nearest accessible egress, and lack of designation and egress signs.

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Toilet Rooms

Accessibility issues include dispensers that protrude into the circulation path and toilet paper dispenser mounted above the grab bar in all four (4) of the toilet rooms. The men's basement toilet room accessible compartment has a side grab bar that is mounted lower than the minimum allowed and a urinal that is mounted higher than allowed. The women's basement toilet room accessible compartment has a toilet that is positioned farther than allowed from the side wall, and exposed plumbing under the lavatory.

Kitchen

Accessibility issues with the kitchen, if it is used by members of the public, include a sink that is mounted higher than the maximum height allowed. The sink also has exposed plumbing and lacks knee and toe clearance. A cooktop in the kitchen lacks knee and toe clearance and also lacks controls that don't require reaching across the burners. There is also a lack of a wall oven.

Assembly Area

Accessibility issues include lack of an assistive listening system in the summer activities room on the first floor where a flat screen television is present.

Note: In each assembly area where audible communication is integral to the use of the space, an assistive listening system shall be provided. Assistive listening systems shall be identified by the International Symbol of Access for Hearing Loss.

Additional Accessibility Issues

- The accessible parking identification sign on the east of the building is mounted higher than allowed, and the accessible parking space on the west side of the building lacks a sign with the designation, "Van Accessible".
- The ramp leading to the main entrance lacks continuous handrails.
- Door threshold are higher than the maximum height allowed.

Order of Magnitude Cost Estimates

- Renovate and provide exterior accessible routes: \$4,112
- Renovate toilet rooms: \$9,152
- Renovate and provide compliant signage: \$4,404
- Provide an assistive listening system: \$1,214
- Miscellaneous corrective actions (parking, egress stair handrails, door thresholds, etc.): \$6,506

*Total: \$25,388

*Note: Cost to correct the excessive slopes at an interior basement ramp and for renovations to the kitchen sink and cooktop are not included.

Best Practice and Inclusive Design

Best practice and inclusive design recommendations include elements that are not required in the standards but may create enhanced experiences for all users.

- Recommend providing color photos of the Vernon Coleman mural on the second floor at an accessible location in the building and on the Town's web site.
- Recommend providing contrasting color strips on all stair treads.
