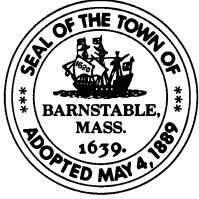

Restrictions:

- 1) **Boat owners/fishermen will be given priority use of town ramps.**
- 2) **There must be two (2) employees on the vehicle while touring.**
- 3) **Staging area will not block town sidewalk to foot traffic.**
- 4) **Staging area will be kept clean at all times while amphibious tours are in operation.**
- 5) **Public address system must not disturb residents in residential areas.**
- 6) **Amphibious vehicles must meet United States Coast Guard requirements.**
- 7) **Vehicles must stay in approved tour route.**
- 8) **The language contained in the document entitled, "Cape Cod Tours, Inc. License Addendum "A", shall be incorporated as restriction 8 of the License.**

Cape Cod Tours, Inc. License Addendum "A"

1. The Licensees' amphibious vehicles will exit from the Bay Shore boat ramp between 2:30 p.m. and 4:00 p.m. and 5:00 p.m. and 6:00 p.m. only. The Licensee will have three exits between 2:30 p.m. and 4:00 p.m. and two exits between 5:00 p.m. and 6:00 p.m.
2. In the event of unforeseen roadwork or a traffic accident that causes congestion at the east end of Main Street, Hyannis or the road at the Lewis Bay boat ramp is blocked off or detoured, Licensee may use the Bay Shore ramp as an exit at times other than those set forth above. Prior to using the Bay Shore Road exit under such circumstances at such other times the Licensee shall obtain permission of the shift commander at the Barnstable Police Department. The Town of Barnstable will inform the Barnstable Police Department of this license and this condition so that the shift commander is prepared to review the matter in the event of contact from Licensee regarding this condition.
3. The Licensee will turn off its microphone when approaching the Bay Shore Road and will keep its microphone off while traveling in the Bay Shore Road neighborhood until such time as it reaches Ocean Street. The microphone and commentary will terminate when the vehicle leaves the channel in Hyannis Harbor as it approaches the Bay Shore Road ramp.
4. The Licensee or any resident of the Bay Shore Road neighborhood may at any time request a change in the conditions of this license by making such request to the Town Manager who shall hereafter hold a public hearing regarding such requested change.
