1. The celebration will occur rain or shine. All groups must be willing to participate in all weather conditions.
2. The parade will begin promptly at 4pm on Saturday, July 4, 2020. All groups must be in their assigned staging location and in the assigned order by 3:15pm.
3. All participants, groups, and organizations are expected to reflect the parade theme in some form.
4. Political candidates may have up to five (5) walkers and one (1) vehicle.
5. Businesses may have up to ten (10) walkers and one (1) vehicle.
6. Throwing of candy is strictly prohibited. Candy may be passed out along the edge of the road.
7. All vehicles must be decorated. There will be NO non-decorated commercial vehicles allowed. "All participants are encouraged to play patriotic or family friendly music."
8. All vehicles participating must comply with all motor vehicle laws including all vehicles must be registered, and insured.
9. Absolutely NO alcoholic beverages are allowed by anyone participating in the parade.
10. Absolutely NO water spraying devices including, but not limited to super-soakers, water balloons, squirt guns, hoses.
11. The Town of Barnstable, all officials of the Town of Barnstable, and the Town of Barnstable Fourth of July Celebration Committee, all their representatives and successors, are not responsible for any loss of or damage to and/or loss of Participant's equipment or the Participant's guests, and/or persons' equipment. All participants are responsible for all of their equipment or property while participating in any and all parade related endeavors.
12. By submitting the online application, all participants agree to indemnify and hold harmless, the Town of Barnstable, all officials of the Town of Barnstable and the Town of Barnstable Fourth of July Celebration Committee, all their representatives and successors, and assumes full responsibility for any risk of bodily injury, death, property damage, loss liability, or cost and expenses that may occur arising out of or related to participation in the Town of Barnstable Fourth of July Celebration and supporting events.
13. Failure to comply with any of the Rules and Conditions of the Town of Barnstable Fourth of July Celebration may result in immediate removal from the parade and/or loss of future parade privileges.
